



Damage to Underground Services

Public liability claims relating to underground damage seem to cause disproportionate discomfort to many insurers. While the general issues do not differ greatly from those found in other kinds of claim, lack of knowledge of the utility industries (from where most of the claims come) and consequent mistrust of on-costs causes problems.
